Enclosed is a form for your convenience. Just complete the form and mail it to the address on the form so a voucher can be mailed to you.

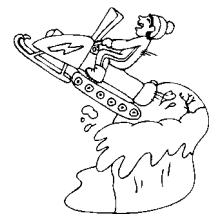
