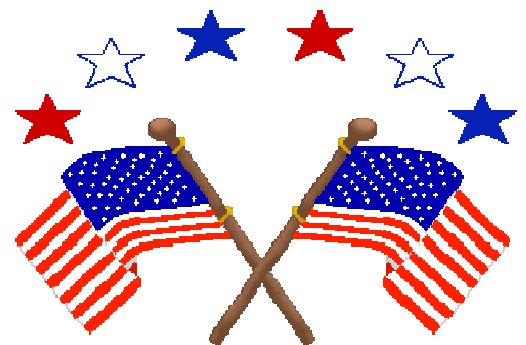

Register your sleds early as this helps to get money to the clubs so we can have the funds available to keep the trails smooth and safe for your riding equipment.

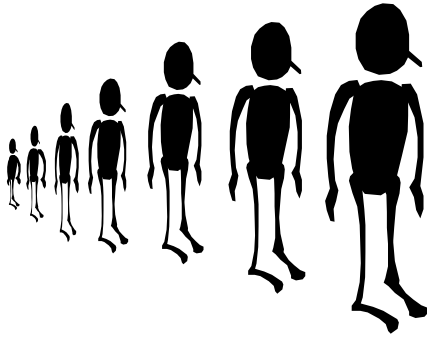

2011 / 2012 MEMBERSHIPS

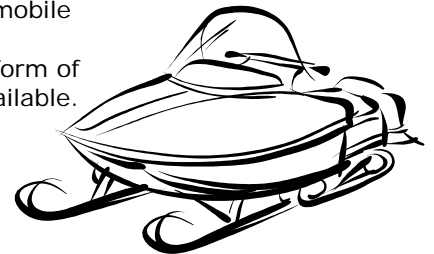
